

Construction of 69MW Msenge Emoyeni windfarm

The Msenge Emoyeni wind farm located in the Eastern Cape currently has one of the most aggressive construction schedules in South Africa.

- Construction commenced in April 2023.
- To date 5 turbines have been installed with completion aimed for early in 2024.
- This is the first wind farm of its kind for Sasol with the power being wheeled to Sasolburg to assist with green hydrogen production.
